# November Newsletter

**Purpose:** The purpose of the Monthly Newsletter is to keep all Community Members, owners and renters, up to date on what's going on in Tanglewood II.

The HOA Board meets once per month and makes decisions which affect all of us. The Board makes decisions based on the information they have and input from community members. These decisions concern insurance, maintenance, vendor contracts, HOA fees, future projects, etc. and affect us all. It is very important that community members voice their thoughts and ideas to The Board before decisions are made. Board meetings are available for all community members to attend either remotely or in person. The time and location of the meetings are listed on the community website. Please attend or log in.

The HOA Board is comprised of volunteers. Currently, they are short 1 member. Anyone who so desires should seek to be a Board member.

We all live together in Tanglewood II. We are all responsible for what happens. Our individual actions can have an impact on the other 80 residents. We must work together to keep our community attractive, safe, clean and healthy.

## Trash:

1. Trash not picked up by the County on collection day is still the responsibility of the homeowner who placed it at the curb. It's the responsibility of the owner to immediately remove the trash from the curbside and contact the county for resolution.
2. When placing trash out for pickup, please place it in a container vice just setting it out in a plastic bag. This prevents animals from opening the bags and spreading the garbage around. If one of your bags is broken open, the trash people are not obligated to collect it. That is your responsibility.
3. Trash cans should be removed from the curbside by the evening of the day of trash pickup, not 2, 3, 4 days later. Again, please be respectful of your neighbors.

**Speeding in Community:** It has been reported to the Board that there have been numerous instances of people speeding in the community. This is very dangerous, particularly for all the children we have. As a result, there will be more speed bumps installed next Spring. Please be careful and respect your neighbors.

**Thanks for the Help:** The Board would like to thank all the community members who helped with the erosion control project between 1200 and 1201 Brunswick. There was a lot of shoveling, dirt moving, raking and planting. This is a great example of us getting together to improve our community.

**Visitor Parking:** Last month there were 3 instances of disagreement over use of Visitor Parking. As we've said many times, Visitor Parking, no matter where it is located, is NOT assigned to any certain unit. Please be respectful of your neighbors and their guests.

**X-Walk Across Bay Green:** For a second time we are trying to convince the county to install a crosswalk at Andrew Hill across Bay Green. This is a very busy crossing area used by people going to the shopping center and school kids. The county refuses because they say the visibility is limited coming down Bay Green from Brunswick. There are some options such as a sign or flashing light. It would help if our residents contacted AA County traffic control or our rep Amanda Fiedler. Keep in mind, as it stands now, after the crosswalk at Brunswick the next is way down past Bay Dale.
